

# Extreme Sports - Motocross



Mounted CCD camera with USE-WiCC (Battery operated)

OPTION 1:  
Camera is connected to wireless transmitter, which streams images

OPTION 2:  
Camera is connected to portable recorder with instant replay and 3-4 hours of recording time

Filming extreme sports from first person perspective increases excitement for the fans and gives viewers a unique and memorable viewing experience. Not only is accomplishing this feat dangerous, but the equipment used must be rugged, lightweight, and have wireless capabilities for making adjustments remotely.



### Solution:

A CCD camera is equipped with USE-WiCC (wireless camera controller) and shock mounted onto the handlebars (for steady filming) of the motocross bike.

The camera can then transmit the captured images wirelessly to the broadcasting control room, or they can be recorded directly onto a solid state drive. If the camera transmits the images wirelessly, it is connected to wireless video transmitter which can stream the images to the control room. If the images are recorded, the camera is connected to a ruggedized portable recorder. The recorder allows for instant playback and 4-5 hours of recording.

The system is battery operated.
