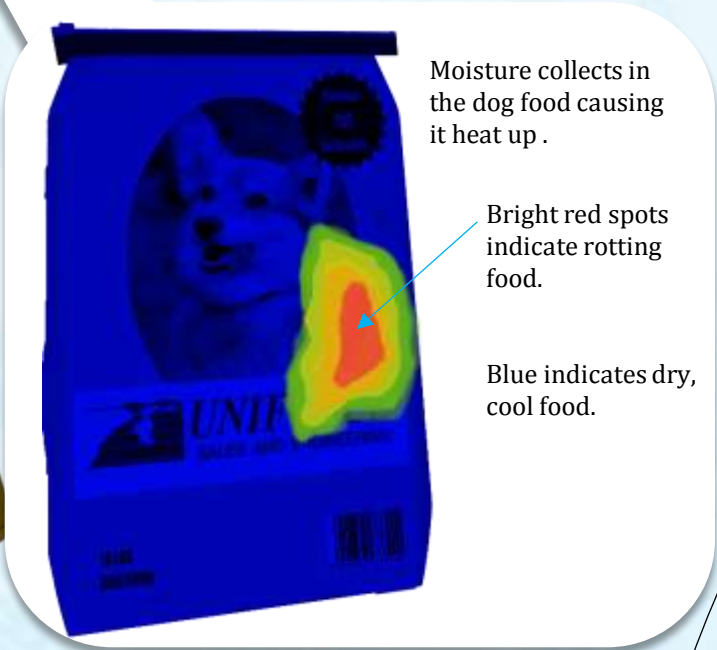


# Dog Food Inspection

Dry dog food is stored in warehouses and must be inspected daily for moisture to ensure the product is still dry. Otherwise, the moisture in the food will cause chemical reactions which could result in explosions, or it will cause the growth of microorganisms resulting in spoilage.

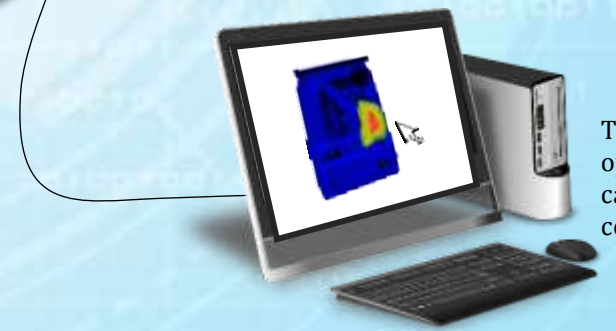


### Solution:

Several pan tilt zoom (PTZ) infrared (IR) cameras are positioned throughout the warehouse. They are connected to a computer and remotely operated by the inspector.

The PTZ IR cameras survey the bags of dog food. The infrared imagery enables the inspector to detect bags which contain moisture.

Bright red areas indicate bags which are heating up due to the moisture and must be removed.



The inspector remotely operates several PTZ IR cameras from the computer
